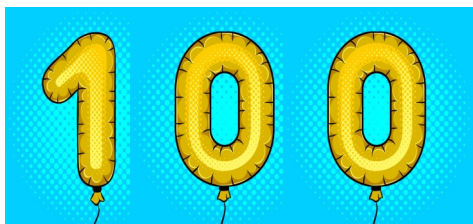

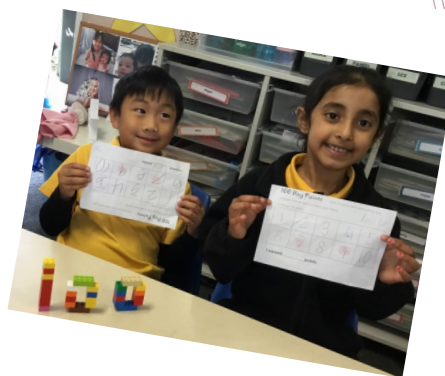


# YEAR ONES DAYS OF SCHOOL

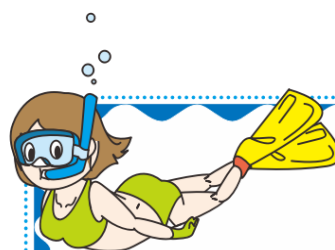

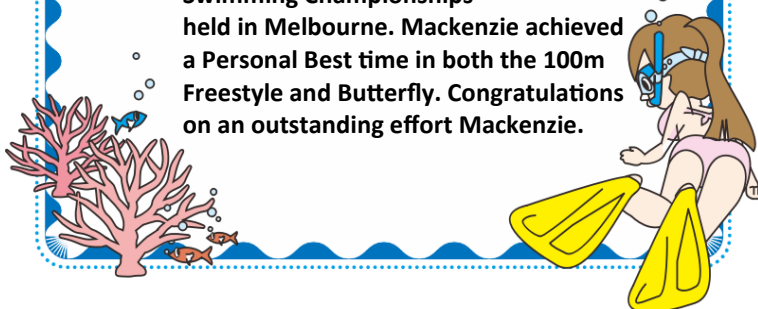
