The choir performed to 14,000 people for over an hour singing 12 different songs.

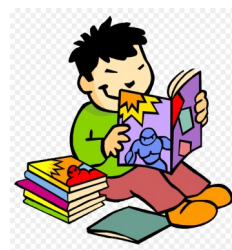
There were also several special guest performers including Jordan Anthony who was runner-up on "The Voice".

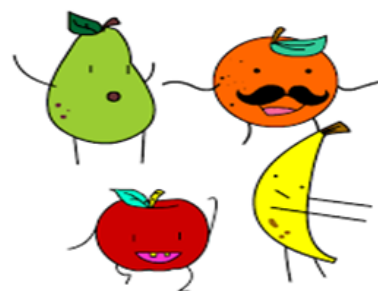
